

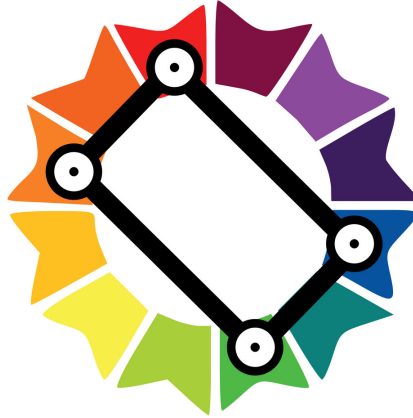
# COLOR SCHEMES

## Complementary



**Complementary color scheme**  
Colors that are opposite each other on the colorwheel are considered to be complementary colors

## Rectangle (Tetradic)



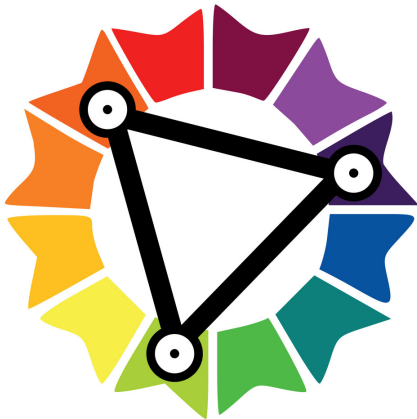
**Rectangle (tetradic) color scheme**  
The rectangle or tetradic color scheme uses four colors arranged into two complementary pairs

## Analogous



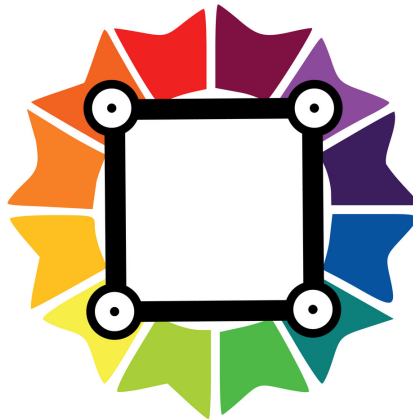
**Analogous color scheme**  
Analogous color schemes use colors that are next to each other on the color wheel

## Triadic



**Triadic color scheme**  
A triadic color scheme uses colors that are evenly spaced around the color wheel

## Square



**Square color scheme**  
The square color scheme is similar to the rectangle, but with four colors spaced evenly around the color circle

## Split Complement



**Split-Complementary color scheme**  
The split-complementary colors scheme is variation of the complementary color scheme. In addition to the base color, it uses the two colors adjacent to its complement
